Frequently Asked Questions for Performances and Rehearsals CHERUBS, JOY, PRE-BALLET, BALLET 1, BALLET 2 & BALLET 3

How do I style my daughter's hair for the dress rehearsal and performance?

Hair should be slicked back into a classical ballet bun, using hair gel, hair spray, bobby pins and a hair net, and when applicable, approved hair accessory that goes with costume. DO NOT PUT GLITTER OR ANYTHING SPARKLY IN HAIR (INCLUDING GLITTER SPRAY).

How much, if any Make-Up should be worn?

Cherubs, Joy, Pre-ballet, Ballet 1 and Ballet 2 dancers should wear mild make-up: rose colored lipstick, blush, and mascara; Ballet 3 should wear rose colored lipstick, blush, mascara, eye liner, and light eye shadow. No Jewelry or Nail Polish is allowed

What will they wear for the Performances?

Students will wear their costume, pink tights and pink leather ballet shoes to the facility. Please don't forget any accessories that might be included with their costumes, such as hair pieces or arms bands.

What kinds of tights and Shoes do they wear?

Ballet Students wear Pink leather ballet slippers, pink footed tights. Shoes should be in good to new-like condition with elastic sewn, strings tucked in, no holes or rips. Tights should be free of runs, dirt, holes, or sewn patches. No footless tights are allowed. Ballet 3 students can have transition tights, but the feet must be covered. *Jazz Students wear Black Jazz Shoes.

Do I need to stay with my child during the rehearsals?

No. There are assigned Class Monitors, as well as helpers, for each class who are taking care of your child. **Rehearsals are closed** so only approved persons are allowed to remain at the Rehearsal Facility.

What do I need to send with them to rehearsals?

A cover-up to wear over costume when eating snack (provided), book to read, ballet shoes.

When can I take pictures of my child in her costume?

The best time is immediately after the performance. Please keep in mind that after Saturdays Program the Stage Crew will need to start pulling up the Marlie Floor and clearing the Stage 15 min. after the Performance is over.
